For those moments when you need to press a specific part of the screen, you can lock or unlock the mouse at the touch of a button (default is tilde). You can also hide or show the keyboard shortcut minilayer when you're completely used to the controls. The first of these is the scroll wheel, which sometimes reacts unpredictably. The second is sensitivity, which is standard to lightning speed.
